ANGINOX

Trimetazidine hydrochloride BP

Presentation

Anginox Teblet: Each film coated tablet contains Trimetazidine hydrochloride BP 20mg.

Indications

- Ischemic heart disease (angina pectoris, sequelae of infarction)
- Adjuvant symptomatic treatment of vertigo and tinnitus
- Adjuvant treatment of the decline visual acuity and visual field disturbances, presumably of vascular origin.

Dosage and administration

Adult: One tablet thrice daily after meal. No dosage adjustment is required in patients with impaired renal and hepatic function. Child: Safety and efficacy have not been established with Trimetazidine.

Contraindications

Hypersensitivity to Trimetazidine hydrochloride.

Use in pregnancy and lactation

Pregnancy: Studies in animals have not demonstrated a teratogenic effect. However, in the absence of clinical data and for safety reasons, prescription should be avoided during pregnancy. Nursing mothers: There is no information on the secretion of Trimetazidine into breast milk. However, breast-feeding should be discontinued if the use of Trimetazidine is considered essential.

Drug Interactions

No drug interactions have so far been reported.

Storage

Store at a temperature not exceeding 30°C. Protect from direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children.
