Tiemonium Methylsulphate INN

Presentation

Previp : Each film-coated tablet contains Tiemonium Methylsulphate INN 50 mg.

Indications

Previp (Tiemonium Methylsulphate) is an antispasmodic drug. It reduces muscle spasms of intestine, biliary system, bladder and uterus. Previp is indicated for the pain in gastrointestinal, biliary, urinary and gynaecological disease such as gastroenteritis, diarrhoea, dysentery, biliary colic, enterocolitis, colonopathies, mild cystitis & spasmodic dysmenorrhoea.

Dosage and Administration

Adult : The usual dosage of Previp (Tiemonium Methylsulphate) is 2 to 6 (100-300 mg) tablets daily in divided doses as required.

Side effects

Side effects with the use of this drug is rare.

Precautions

Chronic bronchitis, coronary insufficiency, ambient hyperthermia.

Drug interactions

Association must be careful with other atropinic substances: anticholinergic, antidepressants, H₁ antagonists, disopyramide and phenothiazines.

Contraindications

Tiemonium Methylsulphate should not be used in Glaucoma or whose acute pain of eyeball with vision disturbance was found. Also this drug should not be used in patients with the disorder of prostate or urinary bladder.

Use in pregnancy & lactation

The use of this drug is not recommended during pregnancy & lactation, unless otherwise indicated by physician.

Commercial pack

Previp: Each box contains 5 blister packs of 10 tablets.
