Losartan potassium INN

Presentation :

Anreb 25 mg : Each film coated tablet contains Losartan potassium INN 25 mg.

Anreb 50 mg : Each filmcoated tablet contains Losartan potassium INN 25 mg.

Indications :

Anreb is indicated for the treatment of hypertension. It may be used alone or in combination with other antihypertensive agent.

Dosage and administration :

Usually 50 mg once daily (elderly over 75 years, moderate to severe renal impairment, intravascular volume depletion, initially 25 mg once daily); if necessary increased after several weeks to 100 mg once daily.

Side effects :

Diarrhoea, dizziness, taste disturbance, cough, myalgia, migraine, urticaria, pruritus, rash, rarely hepatitis, anaemia.

Precautions :

Precaution should be taken when it is administered to the patients with hepatic and renal impairment.

Contraindications :

Anreb is contraindicated in patients who are hypersensitive to the active ingredient or any component of the drug, breast-feeding.

Drug interactions :

No significant drug interactions have been identified by clinical trials with hydrochlorothiazide, digoxin, warfarin, cimetidine, ketoconazole and phenobarbital.

Commercial pack :

Anreb 25 mg : Each box contains 5 blister strips of 10 tablets.

Anreb 50 mg : Each box contains 3 blister strip of 10 tablets.



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
