Presentation:

Each chewable tablet contains Albendazole USP 400 mg.

Description:

Alzed is a broad spectrum oral anthelmintic. It blocks glucose uptake by larval and adult stages of susceptible parasites, depletes their glycogen storage and decrease formation of ATP. As a result the parasite is immobilized and dies. Alzed has been found to have both ovicidal and larvicidal properties in man.

Indications:

Alzed is indicated for pinworm infection, ascariasis, trichiurasis, strongyloides and infections with both hookworm and pinworm species. Albendazole is also the drug of choice in hydatid disease and cysticercosis.

Dosage & Administration:

Adults and children over 2 years of age: 400 mg (a single tablet) as a single dose in cases of *Enterobius vermicularis*, trichiurasis, ascariasis, hookworm and pinworm infections. The tablet may be chewed, swallowed or crushed and mixed with food. No specific procedures such as fasting or purging are required.

Contraindications & Warning:

Do not use in pregnancy.

Side Effects:

A few cases of gastrointestinal discomfort and headache have been reported.

Pharmaceuticals Precautions:

Store in a cool & dry place, away from light. keep out of reach of children.

Each box contains 5 blister packs of 4 tablets.
